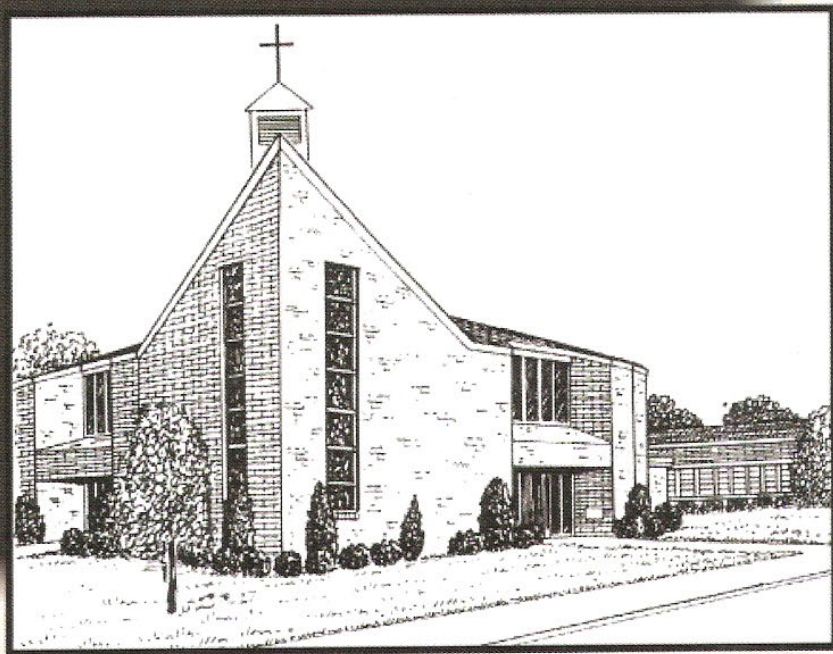

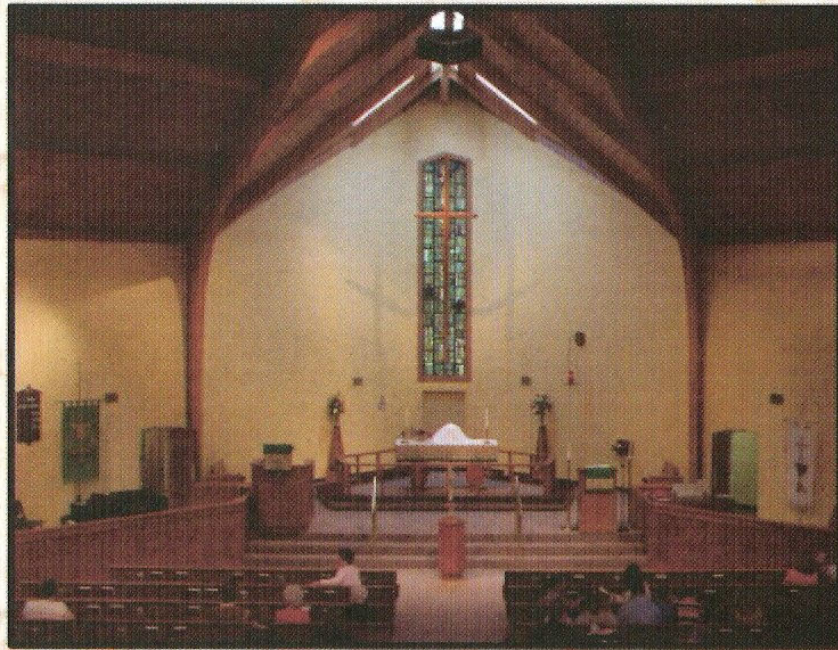

HISTORY

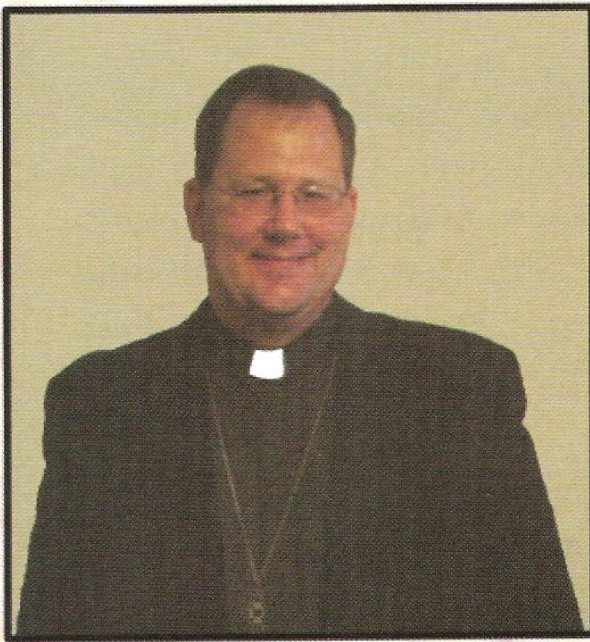
The Lutheran Church of the Transfiguration is a congregation of the S.C. Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and was organized November 21, 1954, with 184 charter members. Worship services were initially held in the Cayce Theatre on State Street.

On April 7, 1957, the first service was held in the new church building. Ground-breaking for the second unit of construction, containing rooms for education and office space, was held March 22, 1964. Ground-breaking for the third unit, including a new sanctuary and additional office and educational space, was held August 3, 1975.

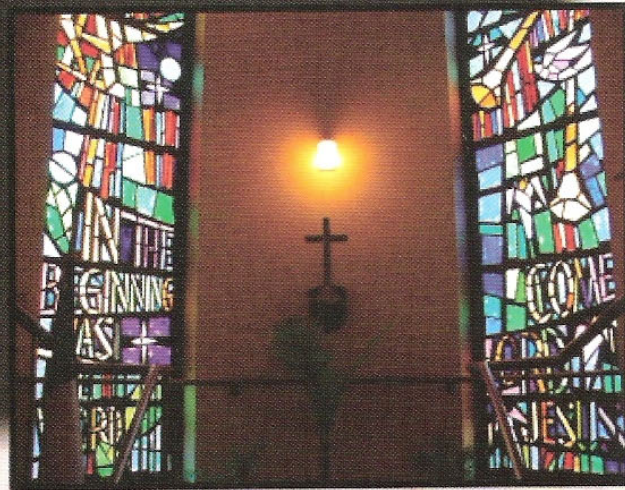
